Steps for the Admission:

- 4. Quarterly Fees should be paid by Cheque in the name of Public School Kharod before 7th of every quarter starting from April as per the fee structure.
- 5. Photographs of Mother, Father/ Guardian and Child to be pasted on admission form.
- 6. Submit Xerox Copy of Birth Certificate with original for verification.
- 7. Submit T.C/L.C original counter signed by D.E.O of the area.
- 8. Submit Xerox Copy of Progress Card of the previous school for verification.
- 9. In case of admission in Mid-session fees for the full session from April to March is to be paid.

SUSPENSION

- → The school reserves all rights to suspend a student, if he/she does not follow the code of conduct of the school. Student may be asked to leave the school on the following grounds.
- ♦ Misusing School Property.
- ♦ Disobedience & Misbehaviour.
- ♦ Indulge in Anti-Social Activity.

ATTENDANCE

♦ Absence from school breaks the continuity in the learning process of a child. It is the duty of the guardians to inform the school in advance about their ward's absence from the school. It is compulsory for students of all grades to maintain 85% attendance during the academic year.

Leave For A Day:

♠ An application must be submitted to the class teacher, at least one day in advance. However, in case of any emergency the application with reason of absence must be produced when the student comes to the school the next day. Parents should fill up the RECORD FOR NON ATTENDANCE in the School Diary. Once a student attends the school he/she will not be allowed any short leave. In case of emergency, the child should be escorted home by the parent with the written permission of the Principal.

Leave For More Than One Day:

- ◆ Students who have been on leave for more than one day must give an authentic reason for their absence.
- ♦ Students who have been on leave for more than 3 days due to illness will have to submit a medical certificate by a registered medical practitioner at the time of rejoining the school.
- ◆ Absence without the permission for more than six consecutive days renders the student liable to have his/her name stuck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted only at the discretion of the principal by paying re-admission fee.
- **♦** If the name has been struck off the rolls for the second time for any reason, the child will not be re-admitted to school.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT

A. Availability of Transport Facility

B. Transport Rules




